
- St. Mary's is not interested in selling the RV Annex Building we do not lease the 2nd floor (4.1 rms)
- The Demographic Data is already 1% off- there are 1% more students enrolled than anticipated.
- By 2026 we are expecting an increase of 10.5% from our demographic study- this can result in a shortage of approximately 150 seats using our district practices
- Current class size average across the district is 19.3 students/ class
