The Denville Township School District and Denville Township Police Department take the safety and security of our students and staff as the number one priority. In order to provide the safest environment possible the district and police have teamed up to complete several projects. Please see the notes below as an update to our security program.

- Security vestibules have been constructed in all three schools.
 - The vestibules are meant as a holding area for visitors prior to being cleared for access to the buildings.
 - When visiting our schools please make sure to have a valid driver's license or state issued identification.
 - Visitors who do not produce the proper identification will not be permitted to enter the buildings.
 - All visitors will be asked to identify themselves and provide a reason for the visit.
 - Please do not enter the vestibule until the party ahead of you has been given clearance.
- Please do not hold doors open for anyone. And please report any security related issues to the principal immediately.
- All schools have been assigned a police officer for the safety and security of our students and staff.
